


Projects to come

What is happening with our projects? After having finished our project in Chad this past July, we decided to continue our actions with our two partners on the ground and start a project that will also touch on access to water and the production of chlorine for water treatment and disinfection. In Malawi, we are still in discussion with different organizations working in the Dzaleka refugee camp. We hope to be able to present the project and our local partners to you soon. Finally, we are planning to start a new project in Cambodia, this time in the prisons of Siem Reap, Preah Vihear and Kampong Thom.

Sustainable Development Goal n°6

ADED's actions contribute to the achievement of the <u>17 Sustainable</u> <u>Development Goals</u> of the United Nations Agenda 2030, in particular Goal n°6.

Why this goal? In today's world, billions of people do not have access to basic water and sanitation services. Two out of five people lack basic handwashing facilities with soap and water. However, access to water, sanitation and hygiene is crucial, because access to these services prevents infections and controls communicable diseases. An article published by the World Health Organization (WHO) and UNICEF stated that the number of people without access to these basic services will be higher if progress is not made four times faster. There is therefore an urgent need to improve the situation in this area. ADED's activities are targeting this problem and we are doing our best to participate in accelerating the improvement of access to water, sanitation and hygiene for everyone!
